NEW OPPORTUNITY TO GROW IN THE WORD: DEFEND YOUR FAITH—Our new bible study offering for members and guests alike begins this Wednesday at 6:30 pm. The objective of this study, titled "Defend Your Faith," is to help Christians be ready to defend their faith when it is challenged by critics, skeptics, doubters, and anyone who would question why we believe. We think you'll find this study highly practical in helping answer objections to the Christian faith, digging into Scripture and in sharing the gospel with others.
