LITTLE FREE PANTRY— Dear friends, we have temporarily made our Little Free Library into a "Little Free Pantry" to share food with those in our community who might be experiencing financial difficulties and food insecurity due to the current school and business closings.

We are collecting donations to keep the pantry stocked. Please bring food that will be ok if it freezes. Choose whole-grain and 100% fruit options when available. See list below for ideas.

Canned soup/soup mixes, applesauce cups, pancake mix (just add water), pasta, pasta sauce (plastic jar), oatmeal packets, granola bars, trail mix packets, whole-grain crackers, peanut butter and jelly (plastic jar), (short boxes of) whole-grain cereal, etc. Small bottles of hand sanitizer and toilet paper would also be appreciated.

Food donations can be dropped at church in the box by the kitchen or, if you don't have a key, we are willing to pick up from your house. We also in need of volunteers to take turns checking and restocking a couple times every day. Contact kara.witthuhn@gmail.com if you are willing to help or if you need donations picked up. APPLE VALLEY FOOD PANTRY—At this time, we are still planning to have our May collection on Sunday, May 3, 2020. Here's the list of needed items for May:

Cereal, plain rice (1 lb. bags and Minute Rice), jam, canned fruit, tomato and chicken noodle soups, chunky soups, beef stews, canned pastas, body washes (adults), paper toweling, hamburger helper, canned tomato products, cake/brownie mixes, all side dishes (potato, rice and pasta) and canned meats (SPAM, chicken, tuna).

If you <u>have insurance</u>, and you <u>have not met your deductible</u>, they will offer you counseling sessions at no charge. Again, you do need to have insurance, and if you met your insurance deductible then your insurance will pay for the counseling. HOLY COMMUNION DURING "SAFER AT HOME"—Because we are not able to gather together in person for worship, there will be no corporate holy communion as part of our services during the "Safer at Home" order. In the meantime, we remember that the same spiritual blessings given us in baptism and holy communion are also given to us through the spoken and sung Word. May our ears listen and our hearts treasure the spoken and sung means of grace today and every opportunity we're blessed to have to do so. FINANCIAL UPDATE—March offerings were again below budget, however due to several generous gifts in January, our YTD offerings are still slightly ahead of YTD expenses. We are thankful that so many of you continue to send in your offerings electronically and through the mail, even though we are not able to worship together in person right now. Looking ahead, we anticipate lower spending in several ministry areas due to the Safer At Home

orders, but continue to fully support our called workers' and office manager's salaries and benefits, WELS, FVL, and our LACE mortgage payment. So we thank you for your continued, prayerful support of Eternal Love's ministries during these unusual times.

At the end of March, our building fund balance sits at \$37,039, which is more than adequate to cover the few remaining punch list items. Therefore, we would ask that members consider re-designating those offerings into the operating fund instead to help cover our ongoing mortgage payment.
