HOLY COMMUNION—Eternal Love will be offering the Lord's Supper to our communicant members this Sunday, May 17, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. We will be able to commune up to nine people at a time. Each devotional service will last about 5-7 minutes. For our safety, we will be using individually wrapped communion wafers and wine cups. The process is easy, please drive into the parking lot. Someone will greet you at the main entrance of the church. Another person will let you know when you can enter the chapel. If Sunday does not work for you, please feel free to contact one of the pastors. They are happy to offer you private communion at your convenience.

LONG RANGE PLANNING—The Long-Range Planning Committee has continued to work on a 10-year vision for Eternal Love and is excited to share those plans with all of you for input and discussion. We have organized several one-hour long Listening Sessions to present these ideas to you and hear your feedback. The two remaining sessions are scheduled at the following times:

We know that our human planning cannot measure up to the plans that God has in store for Eternal Love. But we also know that we have been charged with a mission to spread the message of God's amazing love (Matthew 28:19-20). So we move forward, confident that God does have an amazing plan for Eternal Love, and we pray that through this process, we can clarify and unite around a path forward, all the while keeping our hearts and minds open to God's plan, so that in all of our efforts, God's will be done.

BARGAIN GARDEN THRIFT SHOP— April 1, 2020, marked the 28th anniversary of The Bargain Garden Thrift Shop. Since its beginning, the BG has donated \$1,233,000 to FVL and \$120,000 to other WELS charities. (In 2019 alone, FVL received more than \$124,000.) So far in 2020, \$43,269 has been donated to FVL (\$15,000 for operations; \$28,269 for a van and door projects). While we remain closed to keep volunteers and customers safe, we are anxious to reopen. Notification will be sent to the Federation churches when a date has been determined. *Please keep in mind that although many of you are "spring cleaning," our space to receive donations is limited and spreading out your donations to the Bargain Garden would be appreciated.* We look forward to serving you and raising funds for FVL's teen ministry.
